Role:

To provide administrative and technical support to the AsBo and NoBo Project Leader and the assessment teams in their relationship with RB Rail AS members and the different Latvian stakeholders of the project.

Main tasks:

- Perform a variety of technical and support tasks to a high standard and within budget and timescales to support CERTIFER's lead assessor and assessment team activities and projects.
- Work with other members of your team build on your experience and abilities to ensure continuous support is maintained
- Collate information and reports for the assessment teams to support their activities.
- Write and/or translate official deliverables (from English issue to Latvian one) to be transmitted to the Latvian authorities.
