

Practice day in railway operation

- Operational train preparation, timetable documents
- Technical train preparation, wagon testing, preparation and final service
- Brake technical preparation service, brake tests
- Signals in railway operation, track observation
- Train and shunting operation according to timetable documents or order
- Safety technology in practice (Sifa, PZB, etc.)
- Operational communication with the infrastructure manager
- Securing and parking of vehicles
